What is the best time to visit Alaska?

Because of the long days and variety of things to do and see, we recommend mid-May to mid-September. If you want to see the northern lights, consider February or March. You'll enjoy more daylight then, but still have long nights for aurora viewing.

Do I need my passport to travel to Alaska?

U.S. citizen? You do not need a passport. If you are coming from outside the U.S. or traveling by cruise you will need a passport.

How can I travel to Alaska on a budget?

Travel during the May and September shoulder seasons. Many companies offer discounts then. But even during peak season, we can help find you savings.

What is a self-guided vacation?

On a self-guided vacation, we plan a custom itinerary for you to follow, but you will not be traveling with the same group or guide during your trip. You get to decide when you want to start, where to go, and how long to stay.

Can I take an Alaska cruise and an Alaska land tour?

ANCHORAGE, GIRDWOOD, PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND

Tucked between the Chugach Mountains and Cook Inlet, Anchorage is Alaska's largest city and travel hub. An hour away is Girdwood, a quirky ski town surrounded by hanging glaciers. A little farther down the road is Whittier, the gateway to renowned Prince William Sound.

North of Anchorage, an area equally rich in history as natural beauty. Short for Matanuska-Susitna Valley, the Mat-Su is home to one of Alaska's most remarkable road-accessible glaciers.

Helicopter Flights & Glacial Walks - Flightseeing, glacier landings, and heli-hiking in the Knik Glacier valley.

Hatcher Pass History Tour - Guided tour of the Independence Mine State Historical Park.

Matanuska Glacier Walk - Don crampons and walk on a glacier.

Rocks, Rivers, and Glaciers Hike - Fascinating blend of glaciology, geology, and Alaskan history.



SEWARD & KENAI FJORDS NATIONAL PARK

The coastal town of Seward is home port for day cruises into Kenai Fjords National Park. The town is also the southern terminus of the Alaska Railroad and serves as a connecting point between cruise and rail tours heading to and coming from other parts of Alaska.

TALKEETNA

The base for climbers headed to Denali, Talkeetna's proximity also provides incredible views of the mountain. Brush elbows with climbers, Iditarod mushers, and bush pilots while exploring this eclectic town.

Denali Flightseeing - A fixed wing 60-minute flightseeing tour into the Alaska Range. See even more on a 90-minute flightseeing tour with glacier landing.

Denali State Park Tours - Explore Alaska's best kept secret, Denali State Park, on a moderate guided hike or kayaking tour.

Denali View Zipline Talkeetna - Zipline in the boreal forest.
